## 2.1 Open access and Management

The website mock-ups were initially prepared by Innovation Dis.Co and subsequently shared with the project coordinator to facilitate feedback collection and support decision-making concerning the final structure and design. The website has been developed to meet the needs of the Mosaic consortium and its partners, while also incorporating valuable input gathered during the early development phase.

## 2.2 Modern design and audience focus

**Footer**: Positioned at the bottom of every page, featuring essential information such as funding acknowledgements and contact details.






## 2.6.1 Pages




Figure 1. Homepage

- Bridging the gap from research to innovation by validating solutions through real-world industrial use cases.




Figure 3. Objectives page




Figure 4. Work Packages page




Figure 6. Deliverables page




Figure 7. Publications page




Figure 8. Newsletters page




Figure 9. Media page




Figure 10. News page




Figure 11. Contact page




Figure 13. Mosaic LinkedIn page




Figure 14. Mosaic YouTube page
